36 junior golfers selected to play in 2007 Wells Fargo Junior Pro-Am

(WEST DES MOINES, Iowa) – Thirty-six junior golfers will tee it up June 5 at Glen Oaks Country Club with Champions Tour players during the 2007 Wells Fargo Junior Pro-Am. The junior golfers listed on Page 2 were randomly selected by Principal Charity Classic personnel from more than 120 applications.

"Since the Wells Fargo Junior Pro-Am started in 2002, 180 junior golfers have had the once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to spend a morning golfing with a Champions Tour professional on a championship-caliber course," said Principal Charity Classic Tournament Director Jeff Starr. "The junior pro-am gives two different generations of golfers a chance to connect through a game for which they all have a passion."
