

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

Q. Yesterday on the back nine, you closed with 30. And today you went bogey-free 66. What was the key to keeping that momentum going?

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah, I just kind of scraped it around today. Did a bunch of not-too-good shots really. Not happy with my swing, tell you the truth. But it still could have been better than what it was. It's a weird golf course. Sometimes you get good bounces, sometimes you get bad ones. And I hit a bunch of good shots, but a couple of loose ones. So I got to work on that to have any hope to win tomorrow.

Q. Last week you were in the hunt on Sunday. This week you're playing well again. Something's going right.

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah, it's -- there are a lot of things well. Just there are a few things not so well. So that's -- that's the stuff I need to iron out. The swing sometimes doesn't turn around. I need to hit more fairways and hopefully make some putts. That's what it comes down to.

Q. Is it the greens or --

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah, I would like to see them a little faster. But they have been that way all week long. And every time I have an outpull into the green putt, I leave it short. So that's not a good sign. So I just got to trust it.
