There will be a slight uptick in cloud cover this afternoon, but skies likely remain mostly sunny much of the day. Extended forecast – A frontal boundary is expected to remain semi-stationary across central Iowa this weekend, which will lead to periodic chances for showers/embedded T-storms. The first favorable period for precipitation will be tonight, especially between 11pm-4am. Most of the daylight hours Saturday remain dry before another round of the showers/T-storms develop Saturday night. This period likely features the most organized activity of the weekend. While the frontal boundary lingers over the area during the day Sunday, precipitation development should remain limited. Another threat for showers/T-storms likely develops Sunday night into Monday morning.
