**Today** – Much of the day will feature dry conditions with a mix of clouds and sun. The potential for showers/T-storms will begin to increase after 5pm, and especially towards sunset, as an upper-level disturbance arrives. Temperatures are expected to climb near 80 degrees with a southerly wind at 6-12 mph much of the day. A few gusts near 15 mph are possible this afternoon. Forecast Rainfall: Less than 0.15". **Sunrise: 5:41am / Sunset: 8:44pm**

**Tomorrow** – The bulk of the overnight shower/T-storm activity will be out of the Des Moines area by 9am Monday. As the cold front pushes through central Iowa early Monday afternoon, isolated showers/T-storms could redevelop, mainly between 12-3pm. Otherwise, winds will become northerly with skies clearing towards the late afternoon. Wind gusts of 15-20 mph will be possible after 2-3pm. Forecast Rainfall: Less than 0.10". **Sunrise: 5:41am / Sunset: 8:44pm**
