Q. Second round 65 today, what was going well for you?

ROD PAMPLING: Pretty much same as yesterday, just putting it in good positions off the fairway. Hit a little bit better today, so that was happy, made me happier. Making good putts, making the putts we're supposed to and just not doing too many silly things, which has been unfortunately been around a little bit too much the last month. Touch wood that stays away for another day, we'll see what we do.

Q. What have you cleaned up in the last month?

ROD PAMPLING: Straight between the ears. Really not that hard, wasn't much to do. The game was good in most areas. As I said yesterday, I just had the poor me's going out there; whenever I did something that I thought was good and it wasn't good, I was reacting to it. It's hard to play this game like that, and 30-odd years of doing it, still haven't learned much. At least I have learnt to just let it go this week and see what we can do.

Q. Is it going to be offense tomorrow instead of defense out there?

ROD PAMPLING: Well, you look at the players out there, everyone's just shooting low. Yeah, same game plan. If the pin allows to be aggressive, you be aggressive. If not, play for the middle of the green and see if you can roll a few putts in. The greens are rolling beautiful for I don't know how many months they are, but they're rolling nicely out there. And I'm seeing them well, which obviously helps. Yeah, no change of strategy, just if it's there, go for it.
