RICHARD GREEN (-13)

Q. Richard, 68 today, finished 13 under, just assess your round today.

RICHARD GREEN: It was good for the most part. I had some lucky breaks early on and holed a big putt on 9 that was probably going to go five, six feet past I think and it was lucky enough to go in. That kept the ball rolling.

There was some good stuff. Just got a bit challenging towards the end for me really. I had a really long putt for birdie on 16 and left it short and three-putted from just off the green, yeah, so that was a difficult hole. Then I made sort of a mess of 17 really as well into the wind, that probably cost me in the end. The guys will probably finish off pretty well from where they are now. It was a good result. It's nice to sort of put my name back up there.

Q. This wind, you were on 18 and you see all those flags howling. Just how tough was that wind for you?

RICHARD GREEN: Yeah, really tricky. Probably didn't feel that difficult on 18 off the tee. I felt more difficulty on the chip shot to the green because it was really difficult to get the club on the ball properly and control the shot, so that was pretty challenging. All day we were working hard, all day.

Q. I think this is your third straight top-10. Do you feel good about where your game is right now?

RICHARD GREEN: Yeah, absolutely. Showing really good signs, some good short game signs and good putting. Just work on a couple of little shots sort of in the long game, I reckon I'll get it right.

Q. What's it like mentally out there when you're playing in such windy conditions?

RICHARD GREEN: Really challenging, yeah. It's a difficult enough game as it is without other elements making it difficult for you. Where I'm from in Australia it's a really windy place so I sort of felt a little bit at home with it. 4 under in these conditions is pretty good I think.

Q. What do you make of this crowd here?

RICHARD GREEN: Yeah, a lot of fun. Everybody's been really welcoming this week. Bumped into a few people that I played in pro-ams with over the years and said hello. It's nice to see their faces out supporting again. I've had a nice time with everyone.
