## Things to Know

- Iowa native **Zach Johnson**, who held a share of the 36-hole lead, closed with the low round of the day (67) en route to a four-stroke win at the Principal Charity Classic.

## Zach Johnson, 69-63-67 – 199 (-17)

- The 50-year-old earned his second win on PGA TOUR Champions (eight starts).
  - Wins: 2026 James Hardie Pro Football Hall of Fame Invitational, 2026 Principal Charity Classic
- The Iowa native has finished in the top 10 in each of his eight starts since turning 50 years old on February 24.
  - Remains No. 2 in the 2026 Charles Schwab Cup standings.
- Becomes the second multi-time winner of the 2026 season, joining Stewart Cink (4).
  - Note: this is the 12th event of the 2026 season.
- Becomes the fourth player to win the Principal Charity Classic in his first appearance.
  - Previous instances: Jim Thorpe (2001), Jay Haas (2007), Scott McCarron (2016)
- Improved to 2-for-3 when leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions.
  - Led at the 2026 James Hardie Pro Football Hall of Fame Invitational (Won)
  - Led at the 2026 Mitsubishi Electric Classic (finished 3rd) – Modified Stableford scoring
  - Co-led at the 2026 Principal Charity Classic (Won)
- Improved to 2-for-3 when playing in the last group of the final round on PGA TOUR Champions.
  - 2026 James Hardie Pro Football Hall of Fame Invitational (Won)
  - 2026 Mitsubishi Electric Classic (finished 3rd) – Modified Stableford scoring
  - 2026 Principal Charity Classic (Won)

## Other Notes

- World Golf Hall of Fame member **Retief Goosen** (T2) carded 70 to post 13-under. This is his fifth top-10 finish of the season (10 starts) as he moves up to No. 4 in the 2026 Charles Schwab Cup standings after starting the week ranked No. 8.
- **Richard Green** (T2) closed with 68, including bogeys on Nos. 16 and 17, to finish at 13-under. This is Green's third consecutive top-10 finish of the season and ninth top-2 finish overall on PGA TOUR Champions (87 starts).
- 36-hole co-leader **Brett Quigley** finished T4 at 12-under along with **David Bransdon**.
- Three-time champion (2007, 2008, 2012) and 72-year-old **Jay Haas** (T69) posted 71 to shoot his age or better for the 44th time on PGA TOUR Champions.
- **Paul Goydos** withdrew before the start of the final round.
